E. G. MALLARD, his heirs, assigns, friends, tenants, and successors in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and having the following

land described, to wit:

A strip of land one pipe on the east side of  
Orange Lake Street 17 feet wide the south side of Franklin  
Street, between 81 & 82 Franklin Street, running along  
the north side of said street, 17 ft 3 in 6 1/2 sq ft. A strip  
of land 17 ft wide on each side thereof along real line  
and further to an open space, since 7 1/2 sq ft. 134 ft  
west to the rear nine feet on the east side of Orange  
Lake Street, thence along the east side of same  
17 ft 3 in 6 1/2 feet to the point of beginning.I do understand that the rear part driveway above  
is to be shared in front there for the use of the grantee  
and the other property holder, Orange Lake Street.Also, a bill of sale and affidavit of the lot of land surveyed  
to me by Surveyor associated his deed dated August  
25, 1926, recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds  
Greenville, S.C. page 17.State and County taxes for the year 1926 to be  
paid by the grantee.Also, a bill of sale and affidavit of interest in and to  
the property mentioned above, being 17 feet of land  
adjoining the lot above described, running a frontage  
of 17 feet on Orange Lake Street and running back  
one pipe wide approximately 134 ft. feet.TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or
