W.P. Plumley, all my interest in a certain lot or piece of land, situate in County and State aforesaid and in Class 10, Township on both sides of Janison Mill Creek. Beginning on a large white oak tree on the bank of the creek; thence N. 44-1/2 E. 7.70 ch. to a stone; thence N. 55-3/4 E. 30.14 ch. to stone in place of Hickory now gone; thence S. 83-1/2 W. 14.30 ch. to a pine stump; thence South 34 W. 19.80 ch. to a stone; thence S. 34-1/2 E. 2.76 ch. to the beginning corner, containing twenty-seven and one-sixth (27-1/6) acres, more or less, known as the A.C. Campbell land, now known as the J.M. Blackwell Estate.

Also lot No. 2 of and in County and State aforesaid, known as the J.T. Turner tract. Beginning at a large white-oak tree on branch on S.W.
