(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Willmont Oil Mill, the above certain pieces, parcels and tracts of land situated, lying and being in, Groves Township, Greenville County, and State of South Carolina, and more particularly described in Deed of W. St. Poole to P. R. Bridges, and J. D. Bridges, by Deed dated March 18th 1910 and recorded in the office for Greenville County, on Volume 8, page 58. It is understood and agreed that the said tract is made subject to a right of way, hereinafter given by J. D. Bridges to G. S. C. Railway Co. through the above described land.

Also that other certain piece parcel or tract of land containing less than one-hundredth (1/100) acres more or less, including the right of way from the C. & G. Railroad, to which right of way, I hereby grant all my rights, title and interest in same, as stated in Deed of J. D. Bridges, to me, but do not warrant the latter, thereto, the said tract of land is situated in Groves Township, County aforesaid on the west side of the G. S. C. Railway, bounded on the north by the Piedmont Manufacturing Co., on the east by the Sulphur Oil Mill, on the south and west by J. E. Brumfords and beginning on a hickory tree, thence N. 82° E. 44.40. To iron fence 18 ft. thence back 66' west 5.26 with Piedmont Mfg. Co. line and Liberty Street to factory tract leading to the Piedmont Mill; thence back 1/2 w. with P. B. Blumales line to the beginning corner, all being by intentions to convey to Willmont Oil Mill, all the land so described in Deed of J. D. Bridges to me dated August 7th 1912 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County on the 7th day of September 1912 in Vol. 21 page 124.
