 all that certain tract or parcel of land situated lying
 and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid
 Highland Township, on the waters of Middle Beaver-
 dam Creek waters of middle Tyger River on both sides
 Jordan Road. Beginning on Barnes Branch a conditional
 corner made by or J.W. Mitchell for J. C. Mitchell and
 running to the Jordan road intersecting with the Odam
 line rocks, and running with J. L. Hawkins line orig-
 inally the Odam line to double chestnut, now stone,
 on J.P. Hawkins line; thence with original William
 Mitchell line to a stone original J. P. Dill corner
