WHEREAS, I.M. Wood, J.H. James, Mrs. N.L. James, L.G. Smith, G.D. Wood and Glover Hart, all of Greer, S.C.

did on the 16th day of December, 1924, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.
- SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is The South Greer Electric Line Company.
- THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greer, S.C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to own an electric line from Greer, S.C., to the respective residences of the declarants for the purpose of supplying their homes with light and power, the current for which line to be purchased from another corporation at Greer, S.C., and to be operated without profit.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Six hundred (\$600.00) payable Cash at Organization Dollars.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is twelve of the par value of fifty dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 12th day of December, 1924, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: I.M. Wood, J.H. James, Mrs. N.L. James, L.G. Smith, G.D. Wood and Glover Hart.

EIGHT: That subsequently there was elected as President I.M. Wood as Vice-President J.H. James as Secretary G.D. Wood as Treasurer.

NINTH: That all requirements of Chapter XXXXX, L, Article 1, of the Civil Code of South Carolina, 1922, and all amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greer Citizen a newspaper published in the County of Greenville.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, W.P. Blackwell, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
