EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT WHEREAS, *A. C. Hudson and J. S. Salling, both of Orangeburg, S.C.*

did on the *12th* day of *March*, 192*6*, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given. SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is *Summit Orange Green Bottling Co.* THIRD: That the principal place of business is *Greenville, S.C.*

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is *Manufacture and sale of Soda Soft Drink Manufacture and sale of ice and handling, sale of ice and wood, or Manufacture and sale of ice cream.*
