WHEREAS *H. F. Boyd and E. J. Sloan, of Fountain Inn, S. C.*

did on the *24th* day of *November*, 192*6*, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is *South Carolina Savings Bank*

THIRD: That the principal place of business is *Fountain Inn, S. C.*

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is:

To do a general banking business; to deal in stocks and bonds as a broker; to act as a receiver of individuals or corporations; to act as trustees, as executors, as administrators, and in any other capacities in which individuals or corporations are authorized to act under the laws of South Carolina; to conduct a general fire and life insurance agency business; to own and operate branch banks in such towns or cities as the directors of this corporation may deem advisable.

at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: *Robert S. Small, George Norwood, B. M. Edwards, J. G. Reading and Wesley Key*

EIGHT: That subsequently there was elected as President *George Norwood* as Vice-President *B. M. Edwards* as Secretary, *J. G. Reading* as Treasurer, *Cashier, J. G. Reading*

NINTH: That all requirements of Chapter *XLVII*, Article *1*, of the Civil Code of South Carolina, 192*2*, and all amendment thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in *The Tribune* a new paper published in the County of *Greenville*
