(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Mrs. Nora Greene Mize, the following described real estate: "All that certain tract of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid, near Paris and being known and designated as Tract No. 1, according to a survey and plat of the Estate of Q.A. Greene, et al, made by R.E. Dalton, Engineer, in July 1924, and containing 66 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, as shown by said plat, to-wit: Beginning at a point at the Northeastern corner of Tract No. 2, on said plat, in or near the Public Road, and running thence N. 18.50 W. 155.8 feet to a stone; thence N. 39.50 W. 550 feet to a point at road; thence along said road W. 45.30 W. 372.3 feet to a point beyond the Paris Mountain Road; thence S. 47.20 W. 310.3 feet to a point in old road; thence running along the old road as the line S. 8.28 W. 237 feet to a point; thence S. 18.53 W. 115 feet to a point in said old road; thence continuing along the line of said old road S. 12.28 W. 415 feet; thence N. 81.30 E. 319 feet to a hickory tree; thence S. 28.20 W. 1743 feet to a point; thence S. 28.40 W. 1823 feet to a pipe and stone; thence S. 65.05 E. 652 feet to the corner of tract No. 2; thence along the line of Tract No. 2, N. 28-20 E. 3765 feet to the beginning corner".

Less, however, the three following parcels of land which has been conveyed from the above tract: (a) Tract of 22 acres by deed of Edward C. Greene to Edith G. Coyle, dated May 13, 1926, and recorded in Vol. 126, page 15; (b) Tract of 1.78 acres by deed of Edward C. Greene to R.K. Hill, dated August 3, 1927, and recorded in Vol. 124, page 375; (c) tract of 21/100 of an acre by deed of Edward C. Greene to J.B. Cole, dated April 4, 1927, recorded in Vol. 119, page 359.

Reference is hereby craved to the three last mentioned deeds for a description by metes and bounds of the properties conveyed from the original tract of 66 acres.

"All my undivided one-third (1/3) interest in and to that certain tract of land in Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 58.45 acres, more or less, and described as follows: Beginning at a stone in the Rutherford Road where branch crosses the road and running thence up said branch S. 62-1/4 W. 7.93 to a poplar; thence N. 57-7/8 W. 8.00 to a stone; thence S. 44-1/2 W. 22.95 across branch to pine knot in road; thence S. 77-1/2 W. 1.00 with road to bend in road; thence S. 54-1/2 W. 5.19 to stone at cross roads; thence with said road S. 19-1/2 E. 10.30 to stone in road; thence S. 87-1/2 E. 19.25 to stone in Rutherford Road; thence along said road to an iron pin in road; thence N. 51.8 E. 9.25 to wild cherry; thence W. 20-1/2 W. 5.05 to black gum on Rutherford Road; thence along said road N. 29 E. 6.80 to the beginning."

Dalton in August, 1924, for a more complete description of said 11.74 acres by metes and bounds and courses and distances.
