(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said John P. Lockhart All our right title and interest in and to a certain piece, parcel or tract of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, consisting of 240 acres, more or less, and bounded by the lands of General Pierce, deceased, G.W. Plumley, Claude Plumbley, and others, the same being lands belonging to the estate of Dennis M. Lockhart, deceased, on the waters of South Pacolet River.

Also, a second tract consisting of 237 acres more or less, said tract situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina known as the home place of David Lockhart, deceased, on the waters of Daugh's Creek, waters of North Pacolet River.
