the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said.

C. L. Willis and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in O'Neal Township, said County and State, on waters of Beaver Dam Creek, containing 24 acres, more or less, being a part of the 6594 acres conveyed to C. J. Willis and John J. Willis Executors by deed dated October 20, 1908 recorded in R.M.C. office in Book 333 page 308 reference to which is hereby made for a more detailed description.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or by these or any of them.
