the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said.

The Bank of Commerce, a Corporation, its successors and assigns forever, the following described real estate: "All that certain lot of land in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the south side of Butler Ave. between Hampton Ave. and Buncombe Street: Beginning at corner of H.A. Garrett lot and running thence N. 22 E. with Butler Ave. 65 feet to stake; thence S. 68 E. 137 feet to stake; thence S. 22 W. 6 1/2 feet to stake; thence S. 36.34 W. 29 feet to stake; thence S. 22 W. 55 feet to stake; thence N. 65 W. 179 feet to the beginning."
