the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Henry L. Morgan and his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain tract of land

in the County and State aforesaid, containing *99 1/2* acres more or less, being fully described by plat of *W. G. Heister*, Surveyor, of *Swain* County, of *October 16th*, *1926*, attached to this deed, made to part hereof and to be recorded, said lands adjoining *James Hightower* and *Saluda Lumber Company* and other, and being a portion of tracts *one and two* of the *John F. Hightower* lands so numbered in the partition of the estate of *Stephania Hightower*.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said premises belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversions and the remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, dower, possession, property, benefit, claim and demand whatsoever, both at law and in equity, of the said *Lyda J. Morgan, deceased*

and of all the parties to the said suit, and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, by, from or under them, or either of them.
