said me by the said *Carolina Loan and Trust Co. Greenville, S. C.* the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Carolina Loan and Trust Co., Greenville, S. C.* and its Successors and assigns forever, all

That certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, being in the Township in the First Ward of the City of Greenville and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at the corner of Briggs Avenue and Pinckney Street and running thence S. 32-50 E. with said Pinckney Street 129 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 57-20 W. 51 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 32-50 W. parallel with said Pinckney Street 129 feet to an iron pin on Briggs Avenue thence N. 57-20 E. with said Briggs Avenue 51 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to J. R. Owen by Lula M. Briggs by deed dated July 3rd, 1923, recorded in R. M. O. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 88 at page 379.
