that certain piece, parcel and lot
 of land situate, lying and being in the City of
 Greenville County and State aforesaid, having the
 following metes and bounds, to-wit:
 Beginning at an iron pin on the West side
 of Trotter Street, being 200 feet from the corner of
 lot of land belonging to Slugh, and running
 thence with Trotter St. N. 1/2 E. 50 feet to an iron
 pin; thence N. 69 3/4 E. 123 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 45
 feet to corner of lot no. 14; thence with line of lot
 no. 14 and 10, 176 feet to the beginning corner on
 Trotter Street, being lot no. 9 of a survey made by
