Whereas the above action was begun by Mrs. Frances Chapman against J. E. King and an order of temporary injunction secured against the said J. E. King by the said Mrs. Frances Chapman and whereas, this ^{said} suit involved the title to a small piece of land claimed by the said Mrs. Frances Chapman and whereas, the said J. E. King also claimed said land, and whereas, it is a question of which is the true line between said parties who were adjoining land owners, and whereas, the said Mrs. Frances Chapman died leaving a will and the undersigned David Chapman and Sallie Holliday her executors under the said will, and whereas, it is mutually desired by the executors of the will of the said Mrs. Frances Chapman and defendant, J. E. King to terminate said lawsuit and adjust it in a fair manner:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises the undersigned parties have agreed and do hereby agree each to select a surveyor, which said surveyors shall consult the old deeds, records, plats and other papers of the parties to this controversy and shall thereupon determine where the true line should run between said parties, and the determination of said two surveyors shall be final and binding upon all of said parties and shall finally establish the true line, and that each party to the controversy shall pay his own surveyor.

It is provided further that if said two surveyors cannot agree, they are to employ a third surveyor at the mutual expense of both parties, and the decision of two out of three said surveyors shall establish the line and

shall be binding upon all of said parties. This agreement shall bind all parties individually as well as in their representative capacity, so that when the line of the said J. E. King is established between himself and the Mrs. Frances Chapman estate and Mrs. Sallie Holliday it shall be a final settlement to all controversies as to said line.
