And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, and executors, administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular or in any way pertaining to the said premises unto the said B. W. Emery his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and assigns and every other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof wherewith by witness my hand and seal this the fifth day of March, Eighteen hundred and Seventy five signed, sealed and delivered in presence of
