 Whereas, the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina, by its Act No. 317 approved the 24th day of February, 1921, did authorize and empower the Commissioners of Public Works of the City of Greer to sell or lease the Power Line constructed by them between the Town of Fair Forest and the City of Greer, by and with the approval of the City Council of Greer:—
 and, whereas, the City Council of Greer did on February 15th, 1927, pass a resolution approving of the sale to Broad River Power Company for the sum of Twenty-six thousand, five hundred (\$26,500.00) dollars of said Power Line and all rights of way, sub-stations, and equipment pertaining thereto, running from Fair Forest in the County of Spartanburg to its sub-station in the City of Greer, located in the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, now:—
 Know all men by these Presents, that the Commissioners of Public Works of the City of Greer, in the State of South Carolina, being thereunto duly authorized by said act and approved by resolution of the City Council of the City of Greer, and for and in consideration of the sum of twenty six thousand, five hundred (\$26,500.00) dollars, to it in hand paid by Broad River Power Company, a Corporation of the State of South Carolina, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, set over and delivered, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell, release, set over and deliver to Broad River Power Company, its successors and assigns, all their right title and interest, and all of the right, title and interest of the City of Greer in and to:—
 All that certain 44,000 volt electric Power line and rights of way running from the town of Fair Forest, in the County of Spartanburg, State aforesaid, to the sub-station, located in the City of Greer in the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, and all poles and lines or wires in connection with said transmission line, together with complete outdoor sub-station equipment, including transformers, lightning arresters, disconnecting switches, and other equipment pertaining to this sub-station,
 Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said Property belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining.
 To have and to hold all and singular the Property before mentioned unto said Broad River Power Company, its successors, and assigns forever; and the said Commissioners of Public Works of the City of Greer do hereby bind themselves, and their successors to warrant

and forever defend all and singular the said Property unto the said Broad River Power Company, its successors and assigns against themselves, and their successors, and all other Persons lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any Part thereof.

In witness whereof, the Commissioners of Public Works of the City of Greer have caused these Presents to be signed by J. L. Cunningham, as Chairman, and John R. Robinson and R. Perry Turner, as Commissioners, and its official seal to be hereto affixed, this 7th day of March, in the year of our Lord, one thousand, nine hundred and twenty-seven, and in the one hundred and fifty-first year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
