This Contract made and entered into this the 2nd. day of February, 1928, by and between Jeff 8. Cureton and Charlie Dumit, WITNESSETH:

The said Jeff S. Cureton, in consideration of the rental hereinafter mentioned, has granted, beined and leased, and by these presents does grant, bargain and lease unto the said Charlie Dumit the real estate hereinafter described for a term of four (4) years, commencing this the Snd. day of February, 1928 and terminating on February S, 1932.
