However, should the said G. R. Strickland and Pearl Strickland leave our home through no fault of ours, then our duty to support the said G. R. Strickland and Pearl Strickland and furnish them a home ceases.

In the event we predecease the said G. R. Strickland or Pearl Strickland, it is understood that this agreement shall be binding upon our heirs, executors or administrators.
