Whereas, I, Linton Jones, of Greenville, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, have invented certain new and useful improvements in a Self-Oiling Spinning or Twisting Rig and Oil Trap therefor, and

Whereas, I, the said Linton Jones, have agreed with Mrs. Alma Wheeler, of Greenville, county of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, to assign to the said Mrs. Alma Wheeler a one half undivided interest in any patent issued by Great Britan and a one half interest in said invention as far as said country of Great Britan is concerned, upon the condition that the said Mrs. Alma Wheeler shall pay all expenses inthe matter of applying for the procuring a patent on said invention in said country :

Now, Therefore,

For and in consider ation on the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar to me in hand paid by the said Mrs. Alma Wheeler (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) and for other good and valuable consideration, do hereby promise and agree to assign to the said Mrs. Alma Wheeler, her personal representatives and assigns, absolutely and forever lifetime of the patent, by a good and sufficient assignment, and one half interest (undivided) in said invention and a one half undivided interest in said patent of Great Britan, the right of the said Mrs. Alma Wheeler in or to said invention and said patent being limited to Great Britan and the territories covered by said patent, upon said patent being issued.

Provided, that the said Mrs. Alma Wheeler shall pay all costs and expenses of procuring the said patent.

This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.

And I, the said Linton Jones, agree to execute such document (s) as may be necessary to carry, out this agreement at the proper time (s)
