Knew all men by these presents, that I, Lewis Barber, single of the City and State of New York, in consideration of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) to me in hand paid and other good and valuable considerations by the Greyling Realty Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, and having authority to do business in the State of South Carolina, and an officer in Columbia, South Carolina, in pursuance thereof, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do bargain, sell and release unto the said Greyling Realty Corporation, all those parcels of land described as follows:

1. All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the north side of North Street Extension (formerly known as Spartanburg Road, ) and having according to survey made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of North Street Extension, which iron pin is 60 feet west of an unnamed thirty feet street, and running thence N. 22 W. 200 feet on a fifteen feet alley; thence with said alley S. 68 W. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 22 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on the north side of North Street Extension; thence with the said street, N. 68 E. 60 feet to the point of beginning. Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Laurens Road, which iron pin is 100 feet east of Underwood Street, and running thence S. 15.48 W. 160.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 74.12 E. 50 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 26; thence with line of that lot N. 15.48 E. 159 feet to an iron pin on the south side of the Laurens Road; thence with the southern side of said Road, N. 73.00 W. 50 feet to the point of beginning." Beginning at an iron pin the Southeast corner of Aiken and Pendleton Streets and running thence with Pendleton Street S. 74-15 E. 53.8 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 2; thence with the line of that Lot, S. 44-05 W. 144.5 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 9; thence with line of that Lot N. 66-05 W. 50.9 feet to an iron pin on Aiken Street; thence with the said Street, N. 45-40 E. 133.7 feet to the point of beginning." East 80 feet to an iron pin; thence South 62 degs. 50 mins. East 200 feet to an iron pin; thence South 27 degs. 10 mins. West 80 feet to an iron pin; thence North 62 degs. 50 mins. West 200 feet to the point of beginning."
