all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the west side of Brandon Road (some time called Smith St. in Woodside Ave.) and running thence lot. N. 13° 50' E. 57'-0" to a point in the south line of property now or formerly owned by Mrs. Karen and known as lot #79, thence 3rd. N. 71° 51' W. 111'-6" to a point at the corner of the fence in said line and at the end of the second course described in said from said W. R.
