in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said H. B. Tripp

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

On Alexander Street, just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, known as Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 6 on plat of property of Canton West, each of said lots having the following courses and distances according to survey and plat made January 10, 1927 by Dalton & Neves, Engineers:

Lot No. 1: Beginning at an iron pin, corner of lot of Samuel Briggs, on the south side of Alexander Street, and running thence with Briggs line S. 32-30 E. 83 feet to iron pin; thence with line of said lot N. 67-30 E. 71 feet to iron pin, corner of lot No. 2; thence with line of said lot N. 32-30 W. 83 feet to iron pin on Alexander Street; thence with Alexander Street S. 67-30 W. 71 feet to the beginning.

Lot No. 2: Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Alexander Street, 71 feet east from Samuel Briggs corner, corner of lot No. 1, and running thence with line of lot No. 1 S. 32-30 E. 83 feet to iron pin; thence N. 67-30 E. 42 feet to iron pin, corner lot 3; thence line of lot No. 3 N. 32-30 W. 83 feet to iron pin on Alexander Street; thence with Alexander Street S. 67-30 W. 42 feet to the beginning.

Lot No. 3: Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Alexander Street, corner of lot 2, (which pin is 113 feet east of Samuel Briggs corner) and running thence with line of lot No. 2, S. 32-30 E. 83 feet to iron pin; thence N. 67-30 E. 45 feet to iron pin, corner of lot No. 4; thence with line of said lot N. 32-30 W. 83 feet to an iron pin on Alexander Street; thence with Alexander Street S. 67-30 W. 45 feet to the beginning.

Lot No. 4: Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Alexander Street, corner of lot No. 3 (which pin is 166 feet east of Samuel Briggs corner) and running thence with line of lot No. 3, S. 32-30 E. 83 feet to iron pin; thence N. 67-30 E. 46 feet to iron pin, corner of lot No. 5; thence with line of said lot N. 32-30 W. 83 feet to iron pin on Alexander Street; thence with said Street S. 67-30 W. 46 feet to the beginning.

Lot No. 6: Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Alexander Street 168.85 feet from the center of the car line as at present located on Buncombe Street, corner of lot conveyed by Canton West to Emma West, by deed recorded in Book 108, page 257, and running thence with line of her lot S. 32-30 E. 61 feet to an old pipe; thence N. 67-30 E. 50 feet to iron pin; thence S. 32-30 E. 22 feet to iron pin; thence S. 67-30 W. 68.8 feet to iron pin, corner of lot No. 5; thence with line of said lot N. 32-30 W. 83 feet to iron pin on Alexander Street; thence with Alexander Street 16.8 feet to the beginning.
