(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said George D. James, trustee, his successors in title and assigns, all that certain lot of land in Greenville Towne Street, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being located described in a deed from Nettie James to George D. James, dated July 23rd 1924 and recorded in Book 92, page 450 R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County, having the following lines and corners: Beginning on Sterckwelt corner of Sterling and Main Streets, thence with Malay Street 6. 16. 25 ft. 116. 5 feet, thence 92. 35-35 N. to a point on the east line, Lat. no. 11, thence along line of Lat. no. 11 70. 57 E. 109. 3. feet to Sterling Street, thence with Sterling Street S. 35. 15 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner, and hence part of Lat. line (10) Block 10 Sterling Annex a part of which is recorded in plat book C. page 81, Ward R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.

for the following uses and purposes:
To have the legal title during his natural life
for the benefit of said George D. James, Jr. during
his life and after his death then to be held
by his successors as trustee for the benefit of his
son, George D. James, Jr. until he becomes twenty
years old, then in that event his father
having died said trust shall be discharged and
said land shall be held by the said George D.
James, Jr. free from all trust in fee simple. That
while the said George D. James, Jr. is living, he shall
have the right, said authority to sell said property
any part or the whole of the land and premises
described and described in this deed, either at
public or private sale upon such terms as he
shall consider best; said George D. James, Jr. is
authorized to borrow money on the whole or
any part of said land and secure a mortgage
thereon to the lender by mortgaging said
land for the purpose of improving the building
on said land or to pay any existing liens on
said land, or where necessary for the maintenance
and support of the said George D. James, Jr.
or his son George D. James, Jr. It is provided
however, that the purchase of said land or
the lender of money on account of said land
shall not be required to see to the application
of the funds realized by the trustee.
