All that piece or parcel of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situated and being in the North ward City of Greenville, in the State and Country aforesaid, said having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake on the east side of Anderson Street 65 feet northwards from the northeast corner of Anderson and Nichols Streets (being the northeast corner of the lot conveyed to Mrs. Susan E. Sherman by Mrs. Sarah E. Barnes by deed recorded in office of Register of Meigs County, Georgia for State and County aforesaid in book 45 at page 234 - and thence along Anderson Street 70' 12" E. 70 feet more or less to a stake on Southeastern corner of lot formerly belonging to J. W.
