(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Saluda Land and Lumber Company, a corporation, certain tracts of land situate in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina and being: All those two certain tracts of land described as follows:

Tract 1. That certain tract of land containing one hundred ninety-three (193) acres, more or less, known as the Jassena Harrison Tract, having such shape, courses, distances, buttings and boundings as is shown on a plat thereof prepared by Howard Wiswall, C.E., and recorded in the R.I.C. Office for Greenville County, State aforesaid, in Plat Book F, at page 1, - "A", reference to which plat is hereby craved for a complete and accurate description of the said property; being the same tract of land conveyed December 3, 1885 by Jassena W.
