(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. L. Boone and his heirs and assigns forever,

the following described real estate:
All those two certain parcels or tracts of land
situate, lying being in the State of South Carolina,
County of Greenville, Glaxy Mountain Township,
about three miles west out of the Town of Landrum
and being known and designated as late nos.
3 and 4. According to a survey and plat of the
lands of Mrs. T. M. Belue, made by W. P. Morrow,
Surveyor, March 22, 1925. And having bounds and
Courses, and distances, as shown in said plat.
At witness:

Lot no. 3: Beginning at a stake at the North-
East Corner of lot no. 3, and running thence along
the line of lot no. 2, S. 28 W. 25.00 to a stake; thence
S. 45.30 E. 16.25 to a stone at the Southwest Corner of
