the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Ressie Beneyfield her heirs and assigns,
That one-half of lot No 11, situate on the West side of South Meminger Street in the City aforesaid, as shown on a plat of the lands of the Mountain City Land and Improvement Company made by J. N. Southern and recorded in the N. C. State, in Greenville County in Deed Book W. W. page 6-4 and being that portion of the said lot conveyed to the grantor herein by Mary Tabitha Smith by deed dated January 26, 1924 and recorded in Vol. 82 at page 368. And in more fully described as follows. Beginning on West side of Meminger Street at a point in Center of lot No. 11, thence N. 76 W. 21 1/2 feet to a ten foot Alley, thence along said Alley S 15 W. 21 1/2 feet to a point at corner of lot No. 12, thence across said lot No. 12 N. 76 W. 23 1/4 feet to Meminger Street, thence with Meminger Street 21 1/2 feet to the beginning of said Alley, being one-half of lot No. 11 as mentioned above. And all that other lot of land in the City, County and State aforesaid known and designated as lot No. 16 on the plat mentioned above and situate, being and being on the West side of South Meminger Street and adjoining the parcel heretofore described and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:
Beginning at iron pin on the West side of Meminger Street and the joint corner of lots Nos 11 and 12 and running thence with Meminger Street S 18 W. 43 feet to an iron pin corner of lot 12, thence with line of lot 12 N. 77 W. 20 1/2 feet to an iron pin on a ten foot Alley, thence with said Alley N. 18 E. 43 feet to corner of lot No. 11, thence with line of lot No. 11 S 77 E. 20 1/2 feet to the beginning corner.
