me that piece, parcel or lot of land, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds to wit, Beginning at a stake at a point on the West side of Woodside Avenue and Sanderson Road and running thence along Woodside Avenue in a northerly direction 24 feet to a stake, thence in a westerly direction with line of Houston lot 50 feet, thence in a northerly direction along the lot 24 feet to an iron pin, thence in a southerly direction with line of W. H. Phillips lot 50 feet to the beginning corner on Woodside Avenue, being the same lot of land conveyed to me by W. H. Phillips by J. J. Phillips and W. H. Phillips by deed dated January 14, 1918 recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in said Book, Vol. 42, page 238.

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of the old location of Woodside Avenue, corner of property of Abraham H. Najav and running thence with line of said property 74-18 W. fifty (50) feet to an iron pin, thence S. 18° 36' E. twenty-nine (29) feet to a stake, thence S. 57-30 W. nine and nine-tenths (9.9) feet to stake on the east side of the street or road known as the new location of Woodside Avenue, thence along the east side of said last mentioned street N. 32° 38' W. thirty one (31) feet to an iron pin, thence along line of other property of R. C. Houston N. 57-30 E. Sixty-Nine and two-tenths (69.2) feet to an iron pin in settlement on the west side of the old location of Woodside Avenue.
