(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

*Belham Mills their heirs and assigns all of that certain piece of land or tract of land, situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina County of Greenville and naming the following sixty and bounds:*  
*Beginning on a large post oak 32 about 75 feet south of the West end of the bridge at Belham and thence thence N 84-30 W 45 feet to center of road leading from Belham to Waterville; thence with the center of the road S 23-37 W 576.6 feet to a bend in the road; thence with the road S 30-45 W 199.6 feet to iron pin in center of said road; thence with the gully S 35-38 E 349 feet to an iron pin on the bank of the gully; thence down the gully S 74-45 E 152.5 to any point on the river; thence N 76-45 E 133 feet to an iron pin on the West bank of Enoree river, and at the water edge thence up said river N 30-45 E 724 feet to an iron pin on the water edge; thence up the river N 38-45 W 403 feet to an iron pin at the water edge; thence N 81-30 W 456 feet to beginning corner, containing eleven and forty two one hundredths (11.42) acres, more or less, bounded by lands of Belham Mills and Ernest J.
