Mrs. Ida Johnson, her heirs and assigns  
all that certain piece, parcel or tract  
of land, situate, lying and being in the County  
aforesaid, containing 2.8 acres, more  
or less, and having the following metes and  
bounds according to Plat of H. S. Baldwin Nov  
24, 1926, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin under a  
budge on the Suffletown Road, and running  
3.51 1/2 chains (which a branch of Creek as line) to  
an iron pin; thence 3.47 1/2, 8.50 chains with said  
branch of Creek to a post; thence 3.20, 21.34  
chains to an iron pin on the C. & N. C. R.R. right of  
way; thence with said right of way in a straight  
west direction 5.75 chains to an iron pin; thence  
3.70 1/2 10.85 chains to a stone; thence 2.64 1/2 11.90  
chains to an iron pin in the right of way adjacent  
thence with said right of way 11.22
