Marwood Cleveland, all that Piece, or lot, of land situate in the city of Greenville, State and County aforesaid: more particularly described as follows:

as that certain Parcel or lot of land designated as lot # 30 of the Property of Rush Brothers, on Plat of Property made by P. L. Colton, dated January 1924, and being described by lot # 30 as follows: Beginning at a Point on North side of Buncome Street, joint corner of lots #19 + 20 and running thence along line of lot #19 & 9.046.41.7 feet to joint corner of lots #19 + 20 and lots #13 + 41 thence along line of lot #14 7.69.07 w. 20.0 feet to a Point in line of lot #21 thence with line of lot #21 8.20.04 w. 27.8 feet to a Point on Buncome Street, thence along Buncome Street 5.34 30 E. 24.53 feet to the beginning.
