South Carolina, adjoining lands of Th. R. Jones on the
South, Lot No. 1 of Th. H. Amick's estate and Dr. White's
property on the West, W. P. M. Carter on the north, and
Lot No. 3 of Th. H. Amick property on the east, and
having the following metes and bounds:
Beginning on iron pin in center of road lead-
