 Greenville, in the state and county aforesaid, bounded by the
 Spartanburg Road, about one and one fourth miles
 from the intersection, running on the east by the
 Spartanburg Road, in the South and West by the Old
 High Street, of the Greenville & Spartanburg Railroad, and
 on the North by the old road to C. S. Todd and others, containing
 such acre, or thereabouts, by the deed of Riley J. Lively,
 Surveyor, of the city of Greenville, he deeded said
 land to C. M. C. Book & Co. page 101, and being the same
