C. C. Kennesaw and his heirs and assigns
the following described real estate:
All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of
land situated lying and being in the County
and State aforesaid, in the City of Greenville
and located as follows:
To-wit: That lot of land fronting on Gore
and Spring Streets, in the City and County of Greenville,
South Carolina, being known as Lot No. 5
on plat recorded in Plat Book A, Page 225, and
described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin
on the corner of Gore Street a 12 foot alley,
and running thence with said Alley S. 116. 123 1/2
miles more or less to the corner of Spring Street
and said Alley, thence with Spring Street N.
116. 123 1/2 miles more or less, thence in a Northernly direct
ion 175 feet more or less, to a point on Gore
Street, thence with said St. S. 67 1/2 feet to the begin-
ning corner.
Second: Also, all those two other lots of
land situated in same locality, and known
as Lots Nos. 6 and 19 and shown on plat
recorded in Plat Book A, at Page 225 and
having the course and distances as shown
by same.
An undivided one-half interest in the fore-
going lands was conveyed to me by M. W. Walden and wife
for the County and State aforesaid, in deed Book 74,
Page 517, and the other undivided one-half interest
therein was conveyed by Margaret Kennesaw by deed
dated April 21, 1928, and of record in the S. M. C. Office for
the County and State aforesaid, in Vol. 120, Page 524.
As a part of the consideration for the land
herein conveyed, the grantee assumed and agreed
to pay a mortgage in the principal sum of \$7500
given by C. C. Kennesaw to Mrs. Margaret Kennesaw
August 1, 1922, and recorded in the S. M. C. Office
for the County and State aforesaid, in Book
192, Page 159. This understood and agreed
that the grantee will pay interest on
this mortgage, according to the terms
