EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, Chas. S. Mac Reynolds and W. W. Mac Reynolds both of Atlanta, Ga.

did on the 14th day of July 1930 file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.
SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is Merchants National Advertising Corporation
THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, S.C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is issue and sell books of certificates to be used in the purchase of admissions, merchandise and other things, engage in the advertising business generally, and exercise all additional all powers conferred by law on business corporations.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Twenty five hundred (\$2,500.00) value of the par value of \$50.00, and 50 shares Common Stock of \$50.00 par value payable at the call of the directors. The \$2,500.00 being preferred stock.

EIGHT: That subsequently there was elected as President W. W. Mac Reynolds as Vice-President, Chas. S. Mac Reynolds as Secretary, Chas. S. Mac Reynolds as Treasurer.

NINTH: That all requirements of Chapter XLVII, Article 1, of the Civil Code of South Carolina, 1932, and all amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville News newspaper published in the County of Greenville.
