EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, *J. L. Haley, Marie F. Haley and J. H. Gilreath* all of *Greenville, S.C.*

did on the *2nd* day of *January*, 19*21*, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.
- SECOND: That the name of the proposed Corporation is *J. L. Haley Furniture Company, Inc.*
- THIRD: That the principal place of business is *Greenville, S.C.*

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is *a general retail furniture business, buying and selling merchandise of the character usually handled in furniture stores and doing such other acts as are incidental to such business, such as the buying and selling of real estate.*

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is *Fifteen thousand (\$15,000.00)*

payable *in cash and furniture when character is given and as hereinafter provided*

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is *one hundred and fifty* of the par value of *One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars*

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the *31st* day of *December* at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: *J. L. Haley, Marie F. Haley and J. H. Gilreath*

EIGHT: That subsequently there was elected as President *J. L. Haley* as Vice-President, *Marie F. Haley* as Secretary, *J. H. Gilreath* as Treasurer, *J. L. Haley*

NINTH: That all requirements of Chapter ~~XXXX~~ *XXXX*, Article I, of the Civil Code of South Carolina, 1916, and all amendments thereto, have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three-days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in *the Greenville Post* newspaper published in the County of *Greenville*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, *W. P. Blackwell*, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Means Conveyance or Clerk in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
