 All our right title, and interest in all that certain Piece, Parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Oneal Township, Adjoining lands of Perry Smith, Ottie Johnson, Walter Smith, and Daniel A. Johnson, and being a Part of the sixty-nine and one-half $\frac{1}{2}$ acres tract conveyed to us by deed from Ottie Johnson, Perry Smith, Effie Johnson, Oredia Vaughn, Lola Few, and Daniel A. Johnson, dated deed bearing date of April 15th, 1926, and recorded in the office of the R.M. to far Greenville County in Vol 76 at Page 511, and having the following corners and distances, metes and bounds:

beginning on an iron Pin in the center of an old road, Perry Smith and Daniel A. Johnson's corner and running thence N. 31° 00' E. 40.10 Chains to a stake in new road from Oneal to Green, Stake on Perry Smith's line; thence with the center of the said new road S. 43° 45' E. 1.63 chains to a slight bend in road; thence continuing with said road S. 43° 15' E. 5.27 chains to a stake in the center of the road road, over a culvert and on Walter Smith's line; thence with the said line S. 25° 00' W. 19.32 chains to an iron Pin by the side of an old road, Walter Smith's corner; thence S. 1.00 W. 7.77 chains to an iron Pin, Daniel B.
