Templeton, and his heirs and assigns: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, above County of Greenville in the sixth Ward in the City of Greenville and being known as lot #6-13, recorded in Plat Book, p. ab page 206 and bearing, according to said plat the following metes and bounds: To wit; Beginning at a stake on the north side of Wilkins Street on the corner of lot #6, and running thence along said Wilkins Street, S. 47-20-27, 6-0 feet to a stake on the corner of lot #6-13, thence along said last mentioned street, N. 3-10-31, 17-0 feet and 3-1 ipsides to a stake on the south side of McWay Street; thence along the 3-12-24 street, N. 80-15-3, 8-0 feet to a stake on the corner of lot #6-13; thence along said last mentioned lot S. 2-10-8, 17-0 feet and 6-1 ipsides to the rear corner; thus being the lot conveyed to me by J.
