all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, situate

waters of Roaring River, in Austin Township, adjoining
lands of T. H. Fowler, William Mahaffey, J. B. Hatchett and
others, being a part of a tract of land conveyed
to H. Adams by C. F. Hill by deed dated 21st December
1877 and recorded in Book 44, page 445, Office R. M. C.,
Greenville County and having the following metes
and bounds, to wit: Beginning on an iron pin
on Mill Road on the old line of above mentioned
tract and running thence with the said road
S. 10 deg. 15' 22" chains to angle; thence S. 21/2
deg. 10' ch. to angle; thence N. 89 1/2 E. 1.90 ch. to angle; thence
N. 62 E. 3.20 ch. to iron pin on bluff near the Mill
house; thence S. 18 1/2 E. crossing the creek, 2.84 ch. to
iron pin on old road; thence with said old
road N. 16 E. 2.82 ch. to iron pin in angle of road
