 Headland Bluff, Greenville County, South
 Carolina, being known and designated as Lot
 No. 8 of Cancer Park, property as shown on plat
 recorded in Plat Book 8, page 50, R. M. C. Office for
 Survey, recently run having, according to said
 plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
 Beginning at a stake on the west side
 of 1st Street, point corner of Lot No. 67 and 68;
 running thence with the joint line
 of said lots, 100-87 $\frac{1}{4}$.05 feet to a stake on line
 of lot 70, 72, thence with the line of that lot
 87.05-87.50 feet to a stake, corner of lot No. 69;
