Houston and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described Real Estate, All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, in Ward Two of the City of Greenville, on the South side of East Stone Avenue, and having the following Metes and Boundaries, to wit: Beginning at a stake at the rear corner of Lot of Helena G. Crooksey, about 200 feet from North Main Street and east thereof, and measuring thence with East Stone Avenue S. 13.6: 55.75 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 19 W. 178.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 71.11 W. 55.7 feet to a stake in Hicks Alley; thence along rear line of Hicks Alley and Helena G. Crooksey lot, 164.2 feet to the beginning, or over, the following described Real Estate...
