the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto
the said

R. D. Dobson, and his heirs and assigns forever, the following
described real estate:
"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate,
lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in
Blitch Springs Township, near the Town of Greer and hav-
ing the following metes and bounds: Beginning at cor-
ner of Lot No. 4 on Frohawk Street (Belt Prizes corner) and
thence N. 7 1/2 W. 113 feet to a stake, thence N. 4 1/2 E. 55
feet to Toy Jackson's corner; thence S. 74 E. 113 feet to Fro-
hawk Street; thence with said Street S. 17 1/2 W. 55 feet
to the beginning corner, being all of the lot of land
conveyed to Dink Jackson, Moss Jackson and Toy
Jackson by R. D. Dobson in Deed dated October 11, 1926."
