(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. B. Kemp, his heirs and assigns

All that certain parcel and tract of land, situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, on both sides of the Rutherford Road, in Highland Township, and having the following meter and bounds:

Beginning at a stone, in the center of a road known as Rockwell Bridge Road on the corner of J. M. Forester land and run thence S. 12 E. Two thousand fifty-four and five-tenths (2054.5') feet to a stone on the center line; thence S. 81 W. Five hundred seventy-five and five-tenths (575.5') feet to a stone; thence N. 53-11 W.
