all of my right, title and interest in and to that piece or parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about one and one half miles from Greenville County Court House on McDaniel Avenue, adjoining lands formerly owned by Greenville Cotton Mills, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southwest corner of lands formerly owned by Greenville Cotton Mills, and running thence S. 69 1/2 E. 150 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 77 1/2 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 69 1/4 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the road on McDaniel Avenue, thence N. 7 1/2 E. 50 feet along said road on McDaniel Avenue to the beginning corner.
