TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME: I, E. Imman, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING: WHEREAS, Cecil E. Barton, et al

on or about the 25th day of February in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and Twenty-six exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Hannu Mal Watson, et al

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 18th day of March 1926, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Imman Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Augustus W. Smith for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. 6-1471)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Imman, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$100.00 HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Augustus W. Smith

Said fee nine and sevene forever, the following described real estate, to wit: certain piece, parcel or tract of land containing 20 acres more or less, situate, lying and being in said County and bounded on the West side by Saluda River, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stone 32 1/2 m on R. Settlement road, on Heron Harbetsus line, and measuring thence with said line, S. 3 1/2 W. 7.53 to a stone 34 1/2 m on a small road, thence S. 75-2/3 E. 30.60 to a stone 34 7/8 m from 34 0 m on Heron line, thence along said line N. 1/4 E. 12.50 to stone 34 1/2 m in said settlement road, thence along said road with its original meanderings as a line N. 75 1/2 W. 2.53 to a stone, S. 78 1/4 W. 8.50 to a stone, S. 77 1/2 W. 5.50 to a stone, S. 77 1/2 W. 5.00 to a stone, S. 51 1/2 W. 3.26 to a stone, thence N. 73 1/2 W. 1.43 to a stone, thence N. 64 1/2 W. 3.84 to the beginning. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Augustus W. Smith and his heirs and assigns forever.
