remaining relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 6th day of December 1928 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was

Mrs. Pluser Moore, her heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:
All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, as shown by a plat of the property of Mrs. Pluser Moore, made by H. S. Brockman, January 28, 1929, to-wit: Beginning at the corner of School Street and Moore Street and running thence along the line of Moore Street N. 73.26 E. 268.3 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 14.21 E. 143.9 feet to an iron pin in line of property of the D. D. Davenport Estate; thence along the line of the Davenport Estate property S. 75.00 W. 268.9 feet to an iron pin in line of School Street; thence along the line of School Street S. 14.36 E. 157.2 feet to the beginning corner and being a part of the land owned by Joseph Pitkinney Moore at the time of his death.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons right-fully claiming from, under, or any of them.
