 of Common Pleas of the County aforesaid against Helen Chiles Mattox, Paul Chiles and
Hannie Chiles

Demanding judgment on the real estate described in the complaint, and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 3rd.
 At 12 M^o and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court whereby it was
 adjudged and ordered that the said real estate hereinabove mentioned and described be conveyed by E. Inman
 Master in and for the County aforesaid to American Telephone and Telegraph Company of South Carolina
 for the sum of \$1000.00 to be paid to the said Master as the consideration therefor, in Court and Court will appear. See Judgment Roll No. 1.

 Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid by virtue of the aforesaid decree
 HAVE GRANTED CONVEYED and released unto the said American Telephone and Telegraph Company of South Carolina, a corporation,
 all the right, title, interest and estate of Paul Chiles Mattox, Paul Chiles and Hannie Chiles in and to a strip of land one
 cut in width over said decree, which certain tract of land in the
 County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, mentioned and de-
 creed in the Complaint and Petition, containing 64 acres, more
 or less and bounded by Creek River, lands of Mr. Beesie Eillard
Mr. Victoria Smith, et al. for the purpose and use of a
 right of way for Telephone and Telegraph line, and upon which is
 to be erected and kept pole, wire, cable, conduit, guys,
 wires and other fixtures and appurtenances, that may from
 time to time be necessary and required in the use and
 enjoyment of said right of way.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining,
 and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons right-

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said American Telephone and Telegraph Company of South Carolina, a Corporation, its successors
 and assigns forever, for the uses and purposes as an
 easement hereinbefore stated and mentioned and pre-
 scribed in the Decree in said cause.
