WHEREAS Edgeworth Pace, by his Guardian Ad Litem J. S. Pace

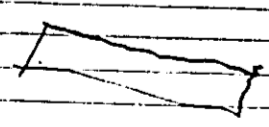

All the right, title and interest of the Plaintiff, Edgeworth Pace, and of the Defendants Joseph Roberson, Frances Roberson, Argie Roberson & W. Emmeth Roberson, in and to the following described real estate:

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in Chick Springs Township, Park School District, County and State aforesaid, having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin the corner of lot herein conveyed and lot no 1, devised to W. J. Kelley by Marion C. Stall; thence S. 71 E. 13.17 to iron pin in branch; thence down the unders of said branch about 2.50 chs. to iron pin joint corner of lot no 3, Mrs. Lucia's lot; thence N. 71 N. 14.00 chs. to iron pin joint corner Lot no 3; thence N. 16 E. 2.50 chs. to the beginning corner



TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same, and of all other persons right-fully claiming from, under, or any of them.
