TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME: E. Luman
Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Samuel J. Henderson individually and as Administrator of the estate of J. H. Henderson deceased, L. J. Henderson et al.

on or about the 25th day of November in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and Twenty-nine exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against May Henderson, et al.

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 17th day of December 1929, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Luman Master in and for the County aforesaid, to J. D. Green

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. 1)
NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Luman Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said J. D. Green

the following described real estate, to-wit:
All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina, in Rutledge Township on a public road leading from the Laurens Road to the Scuffletown Road, containing 55.55 acres, according to a survey made by J. F. Riddle, begun October 1929, and showing the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at an iron pin on a country road at the corner of lands of E. A. Henderson and M. J. Smith, and running thence with line of Henderson property N. 33 E. 11.1 chs to a pin; thence S. 49-45 E. 4.22 chs to a pin; thence N. 28 E. 16.80 chs to a stone; thence S. 64 E. 4.39 chs to a stone in said public road; thence with said public road S. 12-15 E. 5.40 chs to a pin in said road; thence still with said road S. 13.31 E. 5.53 chs to a pin in said road; thence still with said road S. 23 E. 6.75 chs to a pin; thence S. 7-15 N. 18.10 chs to a pin, corner of Foster property; thence N. 74 1/2 E. 23.50 chs to a stone, corner of M. J. Smith property; thence N. 26.30 E. 5.75 chs to an iron pin; thence N. 48.30 W. 4.72 chs to the beginning corner.
